Voting is vital – by mail or at polls – in the Nov. 6 General Election

If you did NOT get your Vote-by-Mail ballot, please call the Registrar of Voters at 714-567-7600. Completed mailed ballots must be **postmarked** by Election Day, Nov. 6. If you forget to mail in your ballot, you may hand it in on Election Day at any Laguna Woods Village polling place – located in CH 1 DR 2; CH 3 DR 1; CH 4 Sewing Room; CH 5 Multi-purpose Room; and CH 6 Main Lounge.
